Topics to Revise	You will be completing a 45-minute listening exam paper, which is structured similarly to how a GCSE written exam takes place.
& Success Criteria	You will hear several pieces of early popular Music (Blues, Rock and Roll etc.) and be asked to comment on the musical elements you hear in those extracts.
	The areas of Music that are assessed include: • Tonality (Major or Minor keys) • Time signatures • Tempo • Instrumentation • Changes in pitch • Comparing and contrasting two pieces • Texture • Dynamics
	The broader musical elements will significantly support you. One key area to achieve success is to always link your musical points to the question. If a question asks you which one you prefer, give musical reasons.
